Agriculture in New Jersey

It is a rare New Jersey resident who has not savored the taste of locally-grown **JERSEY FRESH** fruits, vegetables and herbs. Stroll down to the local farm market and just try to ignore the ruby red tomatoes anxious to be caressed, the fresh herbs awaiting to be sniffed, the sweet corn boasting their bronze tassels, or the plump peaches begging to be squeezed, all waiting to be taken home with you. Farm market customers often find freshly baked breads and deserts in addition to fresh produce. The frequent farm market visit also provides an opportunity to swap family recipes and experiment with new produce varieties.

For the home gardener to the professional landscaper, numerous varieties of **JERSEY FRESH** plants, shrubs, flowers, vines, and trees are available from **Cumberland County's** nursery/greenhouse markets. Everyone's preferences can be accommodated and gardening tips can be obtained. Nurseries are required by New Jersey law to control injurious insects and plant diseases. Plant dealers must agree to purchase stock only from certified nursery sources. The nursery and landscape industry remains the leading sector of the agricultural industry in New Jersey.

Equine Focus

For a number of years, New Jersey has had a reputation for being one of the nation's most progressive equine states. There are over 7,100 equine related farms and facilities covering 81,000 acres of land throughout the "Garden State." These facilities cater to such varied interests as horse racing, trail riding, horse breeding, shows and competitions, rodeos, and riding programs for persons with disabilities. The industry's assets are valued at over \$3.1 billion of which \$682 million is the value of the horses alone. Equine owners contribute over \$600 million annually to the state's economy and directly employ over 5,800 people, not including veterinarians, farriers, jockeys, trainers, and thousands of others who work in jobs vital to the equine industry.

Cumberland County's horse farms contribute generously to supporting the state's role as a progressive leader. The County, though populated mostly by boarding and pleasure riding facilities, has all facets of equine interests within its boundaries. Cumberland farmers are experiencing growth in the equine area through programs like the New Jersey Sire Stakes Program for standard bred horses used in thoroughbred racing and the Horse Breeding and Development Program for the pleasure riding industry.

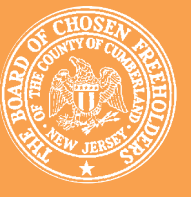

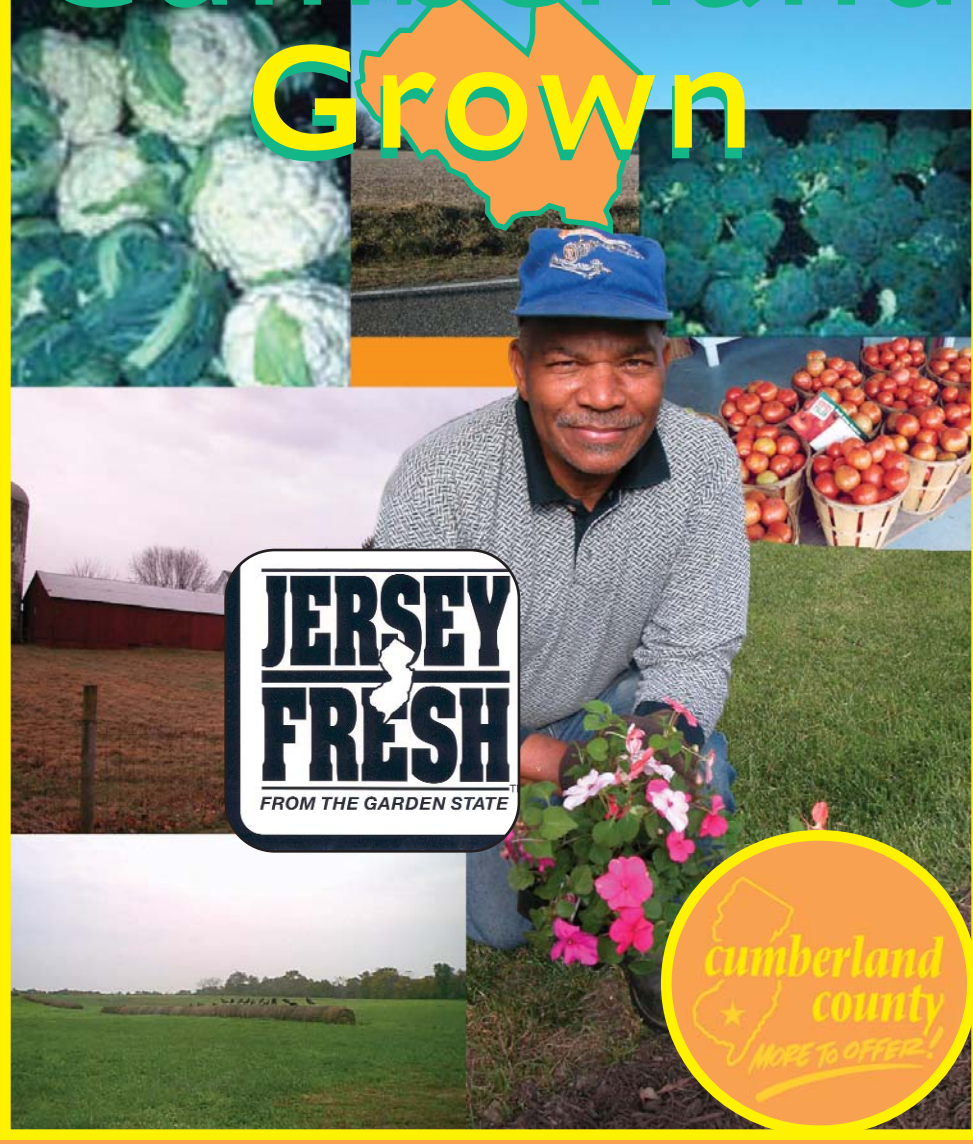

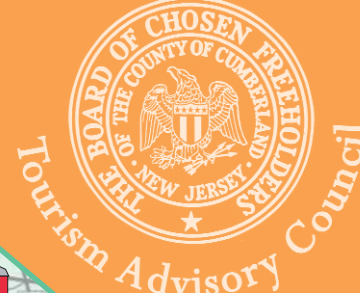
